Durham County Councils **Warm Homes Campaign** provides a range of free schemes to help residents in County Durham to have warmer and healthier homes with lower energy bills.

We have a range of schemes available to help reduce levels of excess winter deaths, cold related illness and prevent delayed hospital discharges.

Working in partnership with the Durham Dales Health Federation we hope to provide information to front line health and social care practitioners to reach vulnerable residents during the colder winter period.

Schemes available are as follows:

Warm and Healthy Homes: Public Health funding to provide free boilers and central heating when residents have a cold related illness

Free Central Heating Scheme: Free central heating systems for residents with a income less than £26,000

Free Gas boiler scheme: Free gas boilers to residents on low incomes and benefits

Free insulation measures: Free home insulation measures not linked to incomes

Free advice on reducing fuel bills, energy tariffs and managing money better
